UPCOMING EVENTS THIS MONTH:

Parents Meeting, April 6: Our semi-annual parents meeting will be held Monday, April 6. We will be celebrating all of the advancement earned by the boys over the past 6 months as well as reviewing all of the rest of our troop activities. As always, a highlight for the evening will be Mr. John's video highlighting all that our boys have done since October.

Manassas Battlefield – April 17-19: Our April trip will be to Manassas, Virginia where the two battles of Bull Run were fought during the Civil War. We will be hiking the battlefield on Saturday. On Sunday we will head over to Mt. Vernon where we will see George Washington's home and then participate in a wreath laying ceremony for the historic site. We need to know who is going by Friday, April 10 since the various sites require advance notice of who will be visiting. The troop cost of the trip is \$40 plus the cost of patrol food. Camp Card Fund Raising: This is a completely optional program that is meant to help out those who are looking for ways to cover their camp costs. We have Cradle of Liberty Camp Cards that the boys sell for \$5 each and the entire profit of \$2.50 per card is credited back to the individual scout's camping account. These cards offer a number of discounts with local merchants. Simply buying at least \$40 of groceries at ShopRite or Acme gives the card holder a \$5 discount at the store, which completely pays for the card. Why not give that money to a scout's camping experience rather than to the grocery store. Other merchants include Papa John's, McDonalds, Applebees, and Modells. This is a great way to help cover the costs of attending summer camp and/or other troop activities. Mr. McKay is in charge of this fundraising event. Summer Camp in July: The troop will be attending Yawgoog Scout Reservation in Rhode Island. We will be leaving Saturday, July 18 and returning Sunday, July 26.
