

Hawk Mountain Sanctuary

COST: \$35.00 per person. This includes transportation, camp fees and Hawk Mountain Sanctuary trail pass. This cost does not include patrol food.

We will be staying at Blue Rocks family camp ground located at 314 Sousley Rd., Lenhartsville, PA 19534 phone 610-756-6366. All COVID-19 guidance will be in effect including 1 camper per tent.

Saturday morning we will go to Hawk Mountain Sanctuary located at 1700 Hawk Mountain Rd., Kempton, PA 19529. It is opening day for the Eagle migration so we should get there early. There is an outside Amphitheater. They will have a rescued Eagle and Hawks. There will be presentations thru out the day. We will be hiking the Lookout trail to the North Lookout. The trail is 1 mile long and easy to navigate, there are several nice lookouts to stop at along the trail.

Each person must have a day pack with a packed lunch and water. We will plan to eat at the North Lookout. In the afternoon we will return to camp. There may be some down time where scouts can venture out on to the boulder field, work on scout skills or just relax.

On Sunday we will depart camp by 9AM. We will be stopping at Priority One Surplus (Army Navy store) and Cabellas both located in Hamburg PA. If you or your scout are looking for camping supplies both locations have a lot to offer. We should arrive home by 2 PM.
