Monday, November 22nd, Troop 3 will be collecting, counting, and sorting donated food items from Scouts and Scouters as we have done in the past.


If Scouts live within the Hatboro-Horsham area, and help out with Pack 17 on the 20th, they can grab a few bags as a contribution to the troops collection.

Halloween Party




On **October 25th**, we had our annual Halloween Party, with a Pumpkin Pie Eating Contest, a Donut Eating Content, and other games and activities.
