The annual Venture Trip to Mt. Washington in the White Mountains of New Hampshire is on for **Saturday February 26th to Tuesday March 1st**. This trip is open to Scouts age 14 and older who hold the rank of Star or higher, as well as parents/leaders. Note that Scouts will need to take two days off from school.

The cost for this incredible and challenging adventure is \$390. \$325 goes to the troop for all food, transportation, lodging and trail fees. \$65 goes to International Mountain Equipment for rental of mountaineering boots and crampons.

We are going to try this again! We will be going to Sterling Hill Mine on **March 18th to 20th**. We'll be sleeping in a cabin at Camp Winnebago.


Cost: \$40 plus patrol food.
