Troop Staff and Committee Meeting




National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)

75th Anniversary Diamond Jubilee




Troop 3's 75th Anniversary is only two short years away, and we want to celebrate in style! We are convening a Planning Committee who will meet for the first time in September.

On **August 6th and 7th**, Nate Snyder and his team of volunteers constructed an orienteering course at College Settlement.




Crew 3 Paddled the Upper Susquehanna River
