Greetings Troop 3!

Wow, July flew by, but it was a great month to be a Scout. We were able to successfully dodge the weather for outdoor meetings on Mondays for weeks... and then there was Summer Camp. We had 18 Scouts and 5 Scouters at Camp Freedom in Heritage Reservation this year, which is a good turnout. We had just enough drivers, and the 4 1/2 hour ride was easy. It was a busy week, as Summer Camp always is. It takes a while to get the schedule down with colors, waiters, meal times, and merit badge classes. Still there was plenty of time for the trading post and downtime playing cards with friends.

and we had stoves and grills with us to do it right. The Dutch oven pineapple upside-down cake Mr. Baranowski made for dessert was awesome.

The camp's First Year Program, Trail to First Class, was great. The Banana Heads earned 3 merit badges each, and completed a slew of rank requirements. Troop Guide Kavish Singh and Outdoor Ethics Guide Jack Coughlin did a tremendous job of filling in the gaps in requirements, including conducting a fitness assessment with mile run, so that they could earn Tenderfoot.

The advancement earned by the troop was fantastic. You'll see the full list below, but the Scouts completed 58 merit badges and 10 partials. Six Scouts ranked up, including 4 of our First Year Scouts earning Tenderfoot. The fifth was only one requirement short, the 2nd fitness assessment to be completed later this month.

At the Staff and Committee Meeting a few weeks ago, SPL Aidan Robin presented the <u>New</u> <u>Annual Plan</u> to the Committee for approval. It was approved with no changes, and we filled in many of the Trip Coordinators already. However, we are still in need of a Coordinator for the November Trip to Annapolis for a Navy football game. Lots of cool stuff coming up in the next Program Year, but we still have one last smash hit coming up in a couple weeks... School Bus Demolition Derby at Buck Motorsports!




Motorboating:
