In order to nominate a Scouter, you must be a registered Scout or Scouter, or a parent of a current Scout.

Nominees must be a current registered Scouter in Troop 3. Nominations for anyone who is not a current registered scouter cannot be accepted. The person nominated must subscribe to the principals of scouting in the Scout Oath and Scout Law and must make a significant contribution to the Troop 3 program.

Nominations are due by March 6th and will be reviewed by the Awards Committee on March 10th. The recipient will be announced at our Spring Parent's night on April 15th.


Nominate a Scouter for the 2024 David W. Cooper Award


