
Both the current TLC and the newly selected TLC officers will have a busy month. We have three meetings this month. One to plan the month of June and two to formulate our next Annual Plan.


No Troop Meeting





Rank Advancement




As of April 23, Leo Baranowski is an Eagle Scout. He passed the District Board of the Review with flying colors.

Congratulations to Leo and the entire Baranowski Family!









