VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

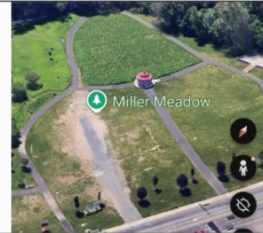
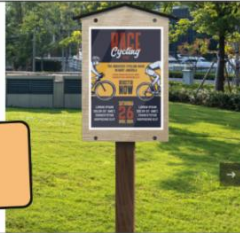

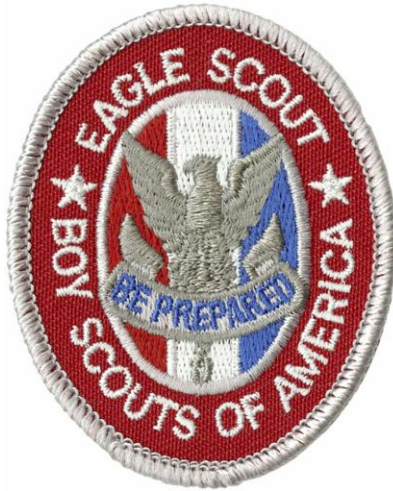
